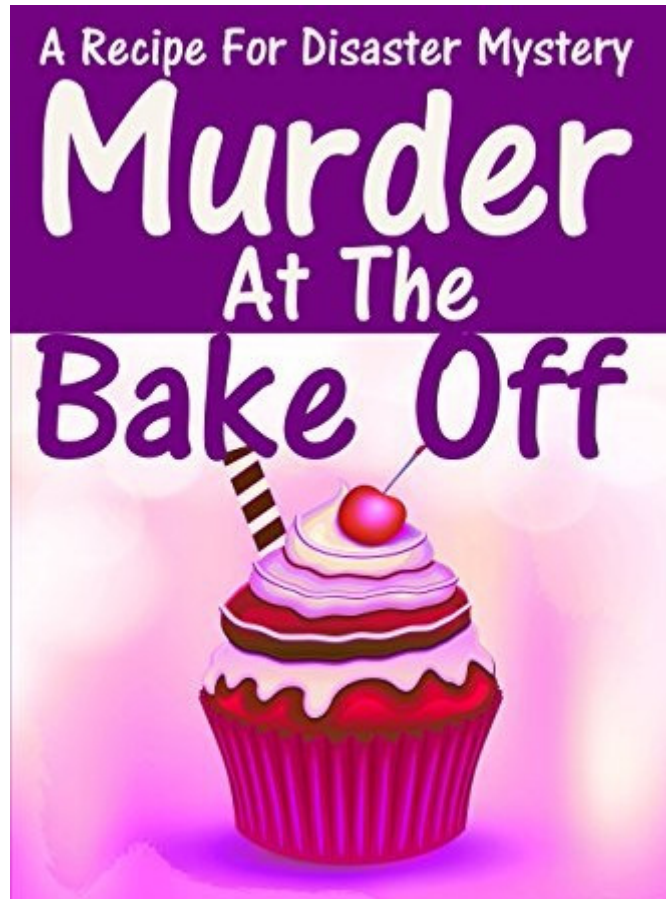
At Ss.Philip & James, Palma
