As we move into day eight of 'Our Kingdom Come' let us spend a few moments in silence and stillness before we begin.....Invite the Holy Spirit to lead us as we read, meditate and pray.....

Father Simon's prayer for us at St.Andrew's

Almighty God Heavenly Father, we praise your Holy Name and thank you for all the blessings of this life. We ask for your forgiveness of all our failings and weaknesses ; and the assurance of sins forgiven. As we gather here in St Andrews Pollenca, following the example of your First Disciples ,may we pray for the Gifts of your. Holy Spirit. That transformed by your love, we may witness to your saving grace amongst all those who live, work and visit in this community. May they see you in us, that together, we may extend your Kingdom in Pollenca. We ask this for the sake of your dear Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen

Reading:

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8.37-39

Reflection:

We expect there must be something that can separate us from the love of God. But God is saying, 'I don't care where you are, what you're doing, how far away you are: my love for you will not change.' Sometimes we think that God's love is dependent on the way we act. But God is saying, 'Listen, not even the heights of this earth could separate me or stop me from loving you.' Christianity is first a relationship with God through Jesus, not first a series of activities! The love of God is ultimately expressed in the Cross of Christ, which stands for all time as the sign and assurance of God's unchanging love.

Prayer:

Loving God, thank You for Your love from which nothing can separate us, and which does not depend on our efforts. Please reveal this love and the peace it brings, in the lives of the five people I am praying for.

Action:

Think about how you can show someone that they are loved and known by God.

The Global Thy Kingdom Come Prayer:

Almighty God, your ascended Son has sent us into the world to preach the good news of your kingdom: inspire us with your Spirit and fill our hearts with the fire of your love, that all who hear your Word may be drawn to you, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

If you plan to go into church today I suggest that you have this handy to meditate on and pray over. Don't forget to cover your five people in prayer and ask God to send His Holy Spirit to guide you in your thoughts and prayers throughout these days of 'Our Kingdom Come' AMEN
