Psalm 67

words of the Psalmist, thrill you with its sense of adoration and joy. Written to be accompanied by a quartet of stringed instruments, the psalm is infectious with its sense of wonder! 'May the peoples praise you, O God ; may all the peoples praise you'. But so often of course, our public worship lacks the joyous sparkle of the Psalmist as we find in Psalm 67. During the Pandemic Lockdown, the Church is having to discover and practice new methods of conveying the Christian Faith to millions of house-bound members. Streaming and zooming are now very much part of our lives, as we seek to overcome obstacles, to communicate that Jesus is the Lord of all.
